Approve Resolution 2014-12 "A Resolution of the Port Commission of the Port of Sunnyside Setting 2015 Wastewater Rates for the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility". Commissioner Matson moved to approve, Commissioner Martin seconded, motion approved 3-0.

Approve Resolution 2014-13, "A Resolution Adopting a Budget for the Calendar Year 2015". Commissioner Martin moved to approve, Commissioner Matson seconded, motion approved 3-0.
