Bob (Robert): Mentioned effluent water is going to the drain. Commissioner Matson asked at what % the CAL (Covered Anaerobic Lagoon) is operating. Bob answered Commissioner Matson by stating that the CAL was designed for 10-12 days of detention time and we are operating it currently 15-20 days. Bob went on to explain that we have lower flows than the CAL was designed for due to the seasonality of our industries and their current construction schedule.

<u>Travis</u>: Stated that he is wrapping up the Anaerobic Digester Project with Apollo.

Gary: Moved the used wheel lines from the newly sold property. Spring barley to be planted north of the concrete slab
