EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:

An estimate from StillWater, LLC was presented. The work listed describes the costs
associated with the decommissioning of wells at the Carnation site. Jay stated the request
of \$25,000 was to cover the project cost plus any additional work that may arise during the
project.

GENERAL COMMENTS:

<u>Staff Comments</u>: Jay shared that he has received calls from two different parties who are interested in possibly developing their business at the former Golden Coin property. He explained the interest is from viable businesses who have a strong customer base. Commissioner Martin commented that it appears all of the work that the Port has done in the downtown area is attracting potential new businesses to the Sunnyside community.
