- Jay provided an update on the ongoing projects at the IWWTF. He informed the commission that the UV project is in its final stages with final criteria for water levels is currently being met.
- The flare project is still ongoing; the meter is being recalibrated to obtain accurate gas readings. These readings will assist in the Department of Energy Services audit, that is currently underway, to determine the feasibility for a potential gas project. The SCADA system upgrades in relation to the MBR project are still under review by Port staff and Parametrix.
- The layout for the airport hangar project was recently received and shared with City of Sunnyside officials. The project is still in the early stages but the outlook is promising.
